



COLEMAN HOLLAND (2002)

Coleman joined the Richmond Shag Club in 1994 and remained an active member for many years. He moved to Kitty Hawk NC in 2002 after joining the Outer Banks Shag Club in 1998. In 1997, Coleman was elected to serve as a Director at Large on the Board of the Richmond Shag Club. In 1998 and 1999, he served as RSC

President and was active throughout the ACSC.

His dance accomplishments include:

- 1996: 1st place in the shag contest at the Carolinian Hotel in Nags Head, NC.
- 1997: 3rd place, Virginia State Fair shag competition.
- 1997: 3rd place, annual shag club team competition at Club Faces in Dunn, NC.
- 1997: recipient of the Richmond Shag Club "Spirit of Shag Award".
- 1998: 2nd place, inter-club shag club team competition, Club Faces, Dunn, NC
- Early 2000's: 1st Place, O.D. Arcade's Rookies Revenge dance contest, North Myrtle Beach, SC
- 2002: inducted into the Virginia Shaggers Hall of Fame
- 2011: inducted into the National Living Legends of Dance (NLLD)

Coleman was a regular member of the RSC Dance Committee, teaching beginners and intermediate shag classes beginning in 1998 until he retired and to Lake Gaston, VA.

In 2001, he taught advanced shag lessons at "Boot Scooters" in Richmond, VA and was guest instructor at the Outer Banks Shag Club Spring Break Party. While living at Lake Gaston VA, he and his wife, Sherren, provided shag lessons where they had never been available previously. Coleman assisted in the formation of the Franklin Shag Club in 2010. He served on the board of directors for 5 years. He and Sherren were the original dance instructors at the Franklin Shag Club for 5 years, teaching beginner and intermediate classes.

Since his retirement in 2012, Coleman and Sherren split their time between Franklin, VA and their vacation homes at Lake Gaston, Va. and Kill Devil Hills, NC.
