Garnet Valos had an unbelievably full and distinguished life, and still had the time to go dancing, as well as being an ardent participator and supporter of the Tidewater dance community. A native of WV, she raised 4 children, owned a dairy farm in Ohio, was past officer of the Order of the Eastern Star, past President of the Princess Anne Business and Professional Women's Club, had an honorary Juris Doctor degree from Widener University School of Law, was member of the year 2000 International Who's Who of Women in Professions and Business, and toughest of all, she was Treasurer for her Church for 35 years.

The dancing comes in when she moved to the Tidewater area in 1965, and the dance of choice, as at most Southland Beaches, was Shag. Somehow since 1990 through 2004, she wedged into her schedule extensive floor time as well as volunteer time in the VBSC, working on every major committee and dancing in all the local clubs.
