- Represented the RSC at the ACSC meeting workshop in NMB.
- Helped with the Central Virginia Junior Shaggers contests and the CSA Richmond contests and financially donated to the Central Virginia Junior Shaggers.
- Attended many of the Living Legends and Hall of Fame inductions ceremonies supporting RSC members.
- Participated in the Guinness Book of World Records event in NMB.
- Continuously takes lessons from professional shag instructors to improve his dance repertoire.
- Has been a multi-year sponsor at the Shad Alberty junior scholarship event in NMB at Mid-Winters SOS.
- Member of multiple shag clubs and attends events at multiple clubs.
- Always there willing to help out with anything needed and is a great ambassador for the shag club, welcoming new members.
- Has demonstrated the shag dance in Australia at his son's wedding and in the Dominican Republic for fellow tourists while vacationing.
