

## TIM SULLIVAN (2011)

Tim Sullivan, a native of Hopewell VA, discovered his love of the music and dance during the 50's and early 60's where he danced at local places like Moore's Lake, the Satellite Club, Fort Lee Teenage Club and the Sheik. He traveled to Virginia Beach on weekends to dance at the Peppermint Beach Club, Top Hat, Jolly Roger and Rogues Gallery. He has

been a member of the Richmond Shag Club since 1990 and has traveled to shag events from Virginia to Florida. He has attended SOS for over 31 years and competed in the 0.D Arcade's Rookies Revenge contest where he placed numerous times before taking 1st place in 2016. He has served on the Richmond Shag Club's Board of Directors for 9 years, including a record 4 times as President, and chaired the RSC Boogie on the James Annual Party in 2010 and 2011. In 2016, Tim was inducted into the National Living Legends of Dance. In 2017 he was recognized by the Association of Carolina Shag Clubs (ACSC) as a "Shaggin' Icon" for his long-standing service to the RSC and to the Shag community at large.

Tim has supported and been a part of the dance and music for 50 years. He is a very sociable person and makes new friends, everywhere he goes. He strongly supports the basic club principle that we are all here to dance and socialize. He makes it a point to dance with women other than his wife or friends and encourages others to do the same. A true ambassador for the preservation, promotion and love of the dance, Tim was voted onto the VSHOF Board of Directors in 2012 and was elected as VSHOF's "Chairman of the Board" in 2022.
